GENERAL NATURE OF JOB DUTIES	
Under broad supervision, this position provides case management services to Housing program participants, will work with the Housing Coordinator to ensure appropriate housing stock, liaise with landlords/property owners to ensure good relations, report all maintenance issues to owners as soon as they are reported to Housing Program. Duties will include monthly housing inspections and rent collections as designated, and assistance with move-ins and move-outs.
