<p>Under general to limited supervision, provide support, advocacy, and linkage to youth and their families. Assists families in interfacing with community providers as part of a collaborative approach to service and/or treatment delivery. This is a full-time position and travel is required/an integral part of the job duties. Flexibility is a must. Ability to work remote and be self-disciplined is also a must. Face to Face contact with youth is expected one per week. Primary work days are Monday through Friday, daytime/possibly early evening hours.</p>

<p>High School Diploma or GED, at least 21 years of age, valid driver's license with three years good driving history AND CPS-Y certified OR *eligible to become CPS-Y after hire within a reasonable amount of time depending on availability of certification course.</p> <p>Preferred Qualifications: CPS-Y currently.</p> <p>*To be eligible to become a CPS-Y you must be between 18-30 years of age, have lived experience of either mental/behavioral health condition and/or substance use disorder as youth and is practicing Recovery as related to that condition.</p>
