GENERAL NATURE OF JOB DUTIES	
<p>Bridge Health is seeking an individual to join our Child and Adolescent Program in the position of Care Coordinator. This is a <i>community-based</i> position that requires travel. WINGA, a program of Bridge CSB, has their primary office in Fort Oglethorpe, GA. However, this position will be covering the counties listed above. Under general to limited supervision a Care Coordinator provides facilitation/coordination of care for youth who have been diagnosed as Serious Emotionally Disturbed (SED). The primary location of the youth served by the Care Coordinator can be within the local school system, within DFCS custody, those receiving DJJ services and also those who are living in their natural home. The Care Coordinator will facilitate monthly Child and Family team meetings in the county assigned and develop an Action Plan for newly enrolled youth as well. Flexibility of schedule is a must, some evenings, nights, and possibly weekends may be required based on the youth and family's needs. This position requires someone who is self-motivated, highly organized, and has the ability to work independently with limited supervision at times due to the nature of the duties. Primary work schedule will be 40 hours per week and flexibility is required. This is a full-time, year-round, position.</p>	
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	
<p>A Bachelor's Degree and two years of experience in Social Services Delivery. Self-starter, ability to manage schedule, work remotely, and ability to document and organize information from a remote location.</p> <p>Preferred Qualifications: Very good computer skills, experience with facilitation, especially with engaging families and youth, and a detailed oriented person would be the best fit in this position.</p>
